5-Step Application Procedure (Old Status)

- Applications has to be submitted to GNF (LL Secretariat)
- Evaluation by GNF Board
- Information (e-mail) of all Living Lakes Members with veto right.
- Living Lakes Secretariat & Board take decision of admission of applicant as candidate.
- The **candidate** gives presentation on next Living Lakes Conference. Vote.





- **3 Step Application Procedure (New Status)**
- Applications to be submitted to GNF (LL Secretariat).
- Evaluation by GNF Board
- Information (e-mail) of all Living Lakes Members with veto right.
- LL Secretariat & GNF Board takes final decision of admission of applicant as **member**.





Criteria for membership and evaluation process

- Applying Organisation has (preferably) an NGO-status;
- Organisation is active in the management & conservation of a specific lakes (water bodies) and its catchments;
- Organisation contributes to the development of the Living Lakes Network;
- Organisation is committed to fulfil the conditions of the Mission, Vision and Terms of Reference of Living Lakes.
- The reliability of the network partners is an indispensable requirement for admission.
